Recent projects and Achievements

Water Well and Solar Panels for Orphanage in Lahore

We were delighted to help secure clean water at the Al Jannat Orhpange in Lahore. The work required boreing deeper into the ground to acquire clean water.

In addition, we donated towards solar panels for the orphanage that will help rectify the ever-present problem of electricity load shedding which is a prominent issue in most parts of Pakistan. Our donation means that the children in the orphanage can benefit from an uninterrupted water and electricity supply.

School in Karachi

COPE contributed towards the building of a small school in Karachi (see below) to teach

vital basics of education. The beneficiaries are children in a poor area of the city. Before our intervention a working class couple that headed this project had already built some of the walls of the school from their own limited resources. They had yet to build the roof, complete the plastering and finishing of the school. With the financial support provided the school is now looking at a completion date in April 2019 which will enable children from a very poor area to benefit from the chance to get educated.

Orphan marriages

Being able to get married is a human right that is often taken for granted in the West. This is not the case in Pakistan where being poor often means that you do not have the means to get married. COPE was delighted to be able to contribute towards the wedding of an orphan girl. Our donation helped attain the bare necessities for a wedding which included, clothes, wedding garment, house essentials such as pots and pans as well as food for the wedding.
